Policy Statement

The Board of Education may enlist the services of consultants to provide specialized advice or assistance concerning educational, management, legal, or administrative matters when knowledge or technical skills are needed that cannot be provided by persons on the staff.

Any proposed contracts with such consultants will be submitted to the Board for approval, and will be accompanied by a budget showing the estimated cost of the consulting project. Where appropriate, bids for consulting services will be sought, with the Board having the ultimate discretion with respect to selection. The appointment of such consultants shall occur through Board action at a public meeting.

Consultants to the Board will exercise no authority over the work of the employees of the school system, but will act only as an advisor to the Board in the field in which they are qualified to provide assistance.
