Policy Statement

The Board of Education is committed to the safety of students who ride a school bus to school.

It is recognized by the Board that the opportunity to ride the school bus is a privilege extended to students -- a privilege which may be temporarily denied or suspended when and if a student's conduct on the bus potentially affects the safety of other students or the driver.

It is, therefore, required that there be appropriate and proper conduct, attitudes, behavior and discipline on the part of all bus passengers. It is imperative that students conduct themselves in the expected manner that will in no way interfere with or distract the driver who must devote his/her full attention to driving and operating the bus in a safe and prudent manner at all times.

It is paramount that parents/guardians take an active role in being responsible for their child/children's conduct on the school bus.
