Good News! Allegany County has been approved for the CEP program that allows us to...


offer FREE MEALS (Breakfast and Lunch) at no cost to ALL students effective August 26,

without requiring Free/Reduced applications from the parents.

This will save a great deal of administrative work from your perspective in the school with not handling the Free/ Reduced appli-

cations. Families can continue to use their PayPams account to pay for extra items (2nd meals, ice cream, water, etc.) as they are not part of the free meal that is offered. All students must continue to go through the serving line for lunch as we have in the past for accountability reasons.
