Kindergarten Registration Procedures

New Students – Students who have never attended an Allegany County Public School (ACPS) must be registered by their custodial parent (biological, adoptive, legal guardian) Every child who is 5 years old on or before September 1st must be enrolled in a kindergarten program in the fall or have an approved maturity waiver.

Students who were enrolled in an ACPS Pre-k 4 Program – Families of students who attended a Pre-k 4 program in the ACPS in-district school will be provided with information from the school regarding necessary documentation to update their current registration.

If the child attended a Pre-k 4 Program on an *Out of District Permit,* he / she will need to register for kindergarten at the child's in-district school. Please make an appointment with the in-district school to register. Out of District permits that are granted for Pre-k may not be continued into future grades. The school principal has the authority to approve or deny the request based on the guidelines for hosting out of district students.
