This year, in addition to continuing strategies from the 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan, we will implement the following in English/Language Arts (which includes Reading, Writing, Spelling, Listening, and Speaking) and Math.

- Evidence-based reading interventions
- Super Kids "Tuck-In" lessons
- Online tutoring
- Online reading experiences
- Distribution of books and materials such as math manipulatives to parents to support students at home in distance learning
- Extended learning time opportunity- virtual summer school
- iReady Math Learning Pathways
- Small group learning such as break-out sessions for enrichment
 Activities to support attendance needs of students such as monitoring
 attendance data and student engagement in distance learning data during faculty
 and grade level team meetings is also a focus. And, Positive Behavior and Support
 Initiatives will also continue to encourage students to do their best.

Parent and Family Engagement continues to be a priority, and three academic events funded by Title I are planned for this school year. They will focus on social emotional learning for all students, literacy for primary grades, and math for intermediate grades.
