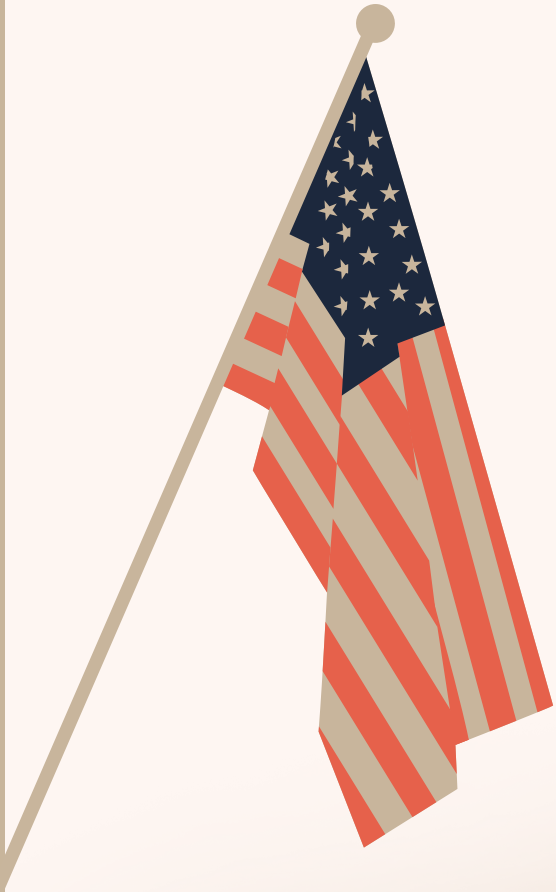


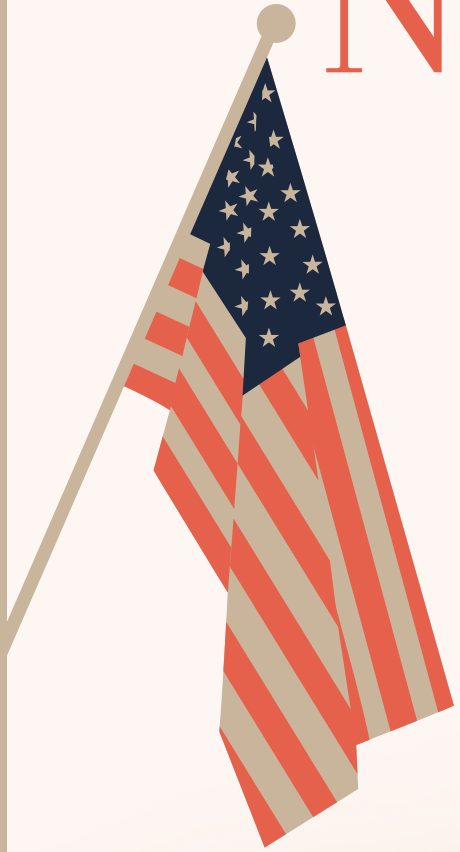

The Army Goes Rolling Along

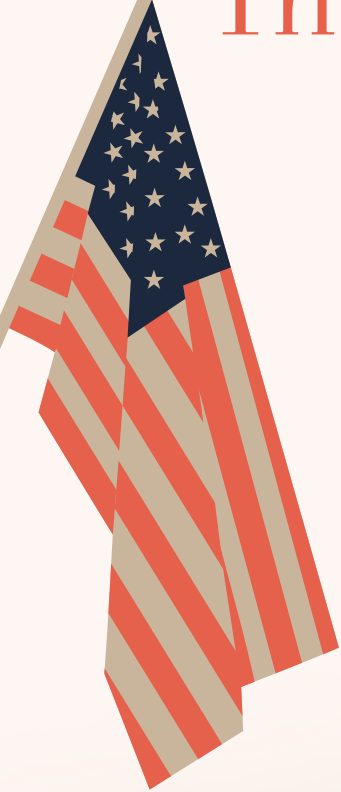
Over hill, over dale, as we hit the dusty trail

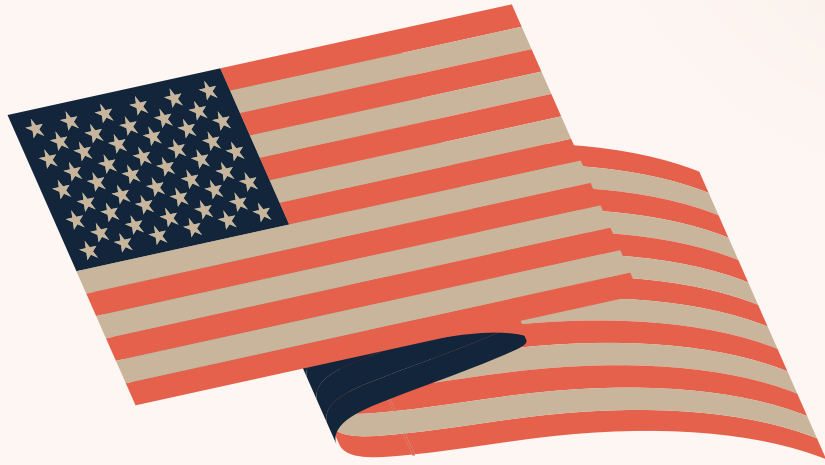
This Land is Your Land
