Students who fail to make course selections during that time will receive a default schedule prepared by their school counselor.


If you have questions about any of the information above, please contact your child's school administrator or school counselor for assistance.

Your selections will be based on the grade specific course selection.

Once you have selected your courses, you may choose the **Post** option at the bottom of the screen to validate your requests and display your credit count. Validation will indicate whether you have selected all requirements or too many to fit in your schedule.

You may continue to logon and make changes until the selection process window is closed.
