Chinese Language Partial Immersion/STEM Classroom Lottery Process Frequently Asked Questions

1. Chinese Language Partial Immersion/STEM Classroom Program Description

West Side Elementary School will host a second kindergarten partial-immersion Chinese program for the 2018-19 school year. Students enrolled in the program will continue through grade 5 and have the opportunity to develop communicative and academic proficiency in Mandarin Chinese and in English.

2. Who can participate in the partial immersion lottery process?

Any Allegany County student scheduled to enter Kindergarten in the Fall of 2018 may complete an application. Participating students will be selected through a lottery process.

3. Are siblings given a preference in the lottery process?

Same-aged siblings' applications will be linked and entered into the lottery as a single application, thus ensuring that families with multiple children applying to the program will be granted admission for the sibling group. Siblings of students already enrolled in the Chinese Partial Immersion Program will be given an automatic seat in the new class.

4. Will older siblings be granted-of-district permits to attend West Side Elementary, should their younger sibling be accepted into the program?

Yes, ACPS is committed to keeping sibling groups together whenever possible. Therefore, if you have an older child who you would also like to attend West Side Elementary, they will be granted an out-of-district permit to do so.

5. Where and when can I get a form?

Entering Kindergarten students must be enrolled at their home elementary school prior to submitting their application. Parents must complete and submit the immersion application for each child interested in participation. Immersion applications will be available at all ACPS elementary schools and at the ACPS website (http://acpsmd.org). The deadline for submitting the application is April 13, 2018.

6. When are the open houses and informational meetings for each of the programs?

Interested parent/students can attend the open house/informational meeting hosted by West Side on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 at 4 PM at West Side Elementary. Please contact West Side Elementary School, or go to the ACPS website for additional information.

7. Is transportation to this program provided?

Parents/Guardians of out-of-district children will be responsible for providing transportation for their student to and from West Side Elementary.

8. When will we be notified of the lottery results?

All students who participate in the lottery process will receive email notification on April 16, 2018. For those not selected for the program, a waiting list is maintained. Students are assigned in a random order to the wait list and are invited to the program when a vacancy occurs before or during the first nine weeks of the 2018-19 school year. After the first nine weeks of the school year, program admission is at the discretion of the superintendent. In order to be selected from the waiting list the student must be enrolled in ACPS.
