

School Procedures for 2020 Scholarship Program

Enclosed you will find scholarship applications from Masonic Charities of Maryland and our Annual Scholarship Program. Nearly \$70,000 will be awarded to Maryland public high school graduating seniors pursuing post-secondary education. One hundred finalists from public schools across the entire state will be selected. Each finalist will receive a \$500 scholarship. From these one hundred finalists, six regional winners will be selected to receive an additional \$1500 scholarship. From these six, three students will be selected to receive additional scholarships of \$1500, \$2,500 and of \$5,000 presented at our Scholarship Reception in the month of May. Our top three students will receive total scholarships of \$3,500, \$4,500 and \$7,000!

The following guidelines are to assist in our selection process:

- 1. Distribute as many applications as you desire or are requested. Copies may be made or we can provide additional applications.
- 2. Collect completed applications with required references by March 1, 2020.
- 3. Review applications for completeness. If desired, you may make recommendations but the lodge scholarship committee will determine final selections.
- 4. Applicants should be considered from the following criteria (in order)
 - a. Leadership in School and Community
 - b. Participation in School Activities
 - c. Personal Resume
 - d. Academics (SAT and GPA documentation preferred)
 - e. Financial Need
 - f. References / Recommendations
 - g. Overall Neatness of Application
- 5. The Lodge Representative listed below will contact you prior to **March 6**, **2020** to pick up any completed applications.
- 6. Winners will receive notification by mail on or about April 17, 2020.
- 7. A Scholarship Reception will be held on **May 17**, **2020** for all finalists and their parents/ guardians at the Grand Lodge of Maryland in Cockeysville.
- 8. The additional scholarships of \$1,500, \$2,500 and of \$5,000 will be awarded at the Scholarship Reception. Finalists *must* be present at the Scholarship Reception to be eligible for these additional scholarships.

You are encouraged to submit copies rather than originals. Any materials you send will not be returned to you unless you specify what particular items you wish returned and provide an appropriate self-addressed, stamped envelope.

With the exception of section III, which must be in your own handwriting, you may type the remaining sections of the application. When using pen, be certain handwriting is legible.

All applications and correspondence should be returned to your principal or guidance counselor by **March 1, 2020**.
