STAFF DRESS CODE

I. All employees must exercise good judgment in their professional appearance for work or work-related activities by always appearing in a manner that;

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- A. Is appropriate to the situation
- B. Will evoke a positive impression from the community
- C. Serves as an appropriate role model for students and the community
- D. Promotes a safe working and learning environment free from distraction
- E. Is conducive to high student and staff performance

During the duty day and anytime employees attend work-related activities; all employees shall appear in appropriate dress. Principals and central office directors/supervisors or their designees shall have the final authority to decide what is/is not appropriate attire for employees working under their direct supervision. Professional employees shall be required to dress in appropriate attire and conduct themselves in a professional manner and are expected to exercise good judgment in the choice of work clothes and conduct themselves in a manner that best represents themselves and the district. Some examples of attire not permitted are jeans, t-shirts and flip flops.

- II. Employees in positions that have supervisor approved attire or uniforms are required to wear them.
- III. College students at every level observing or teaching in an Allegany County school are required to wear ties and equivalent female attire.
- IV. Exceptions to these regulations may be granted by the Superintendent or his designee for special circumstances.
